
TEEN MENTORING:

We are very excited to be expanding our Teen Mentoring programs across the Island! We are currently have students from six high schools and elementary and junior high schools from Summerside to Souris involved. Teen Mentoring provides the opportunity for students in Leadership and Health & Wellness/Physical Education programs to spend one hour per week

volunteering as a mentor with a child. Teens develop leadership skills within a fulfilling, friendship-based relationship with children who need additional one-on-one attention.

IN-SCHOOL MENTORING:

We've been working hard this fall to build our In-School Mentoring program across the island. We spent two days at the Teachers' Convention in November raising awareness of this important program. In this program, adult mentors volunteer with a student, in a school setting, for an hour a



week doing fun and engaging activities which help a child improve self-esteem, gain confidence, and build social skills and relationships. We need In-School Mentors right across PEI and we would love to talk to you if this interests you!

The traditional Big/Little mentoring program provides children and young adults with a role model to talk to and share the experiences of growing up. LAUNCH YOUR LIFE

In late October, our <u>Post-secondary Education and Career Readiness Program Coordinator</u> completed two "Transition" sessions of Launch Your Life adjusting teens to high school in the Bluefield and Charlottetown family of schools. A new "Career Readiness" session began in mid-November that prepares youth for future career pathways. Launch Your Life is a five-week program run with support from the RBC Big Possibilities Foundation. This program has a variety of sessions with modules on topics like self-care, post secondary preparedness, creating SMART

goals, living a balanced life, relationship skills, and so much more. Some former students report improved listening skills, better communication skills, better self-care practices, and having more positive coping skills. Our goal is to expand our offerings of this important program.
