Teen Mentoring in 2022/2023 school year: Charlottetown Rural & Colonel Gray teamed up with Parkdale, Sherwood, Queen Charlotte, West Kent, St. Jean, Spring Park, & Prince St. in Charlottetown. We also had Bluefield & Central Queens, Three Oaks with Elm Street & Greenfield, Kinkora with Somerset, Montague Regional & Montague Consolidated and an internal program at Souris Consolidated. There were 245 students involved in Teen Mentoring during this school year. These programs are quickly coming to an end for this term but we are celebrating the success with cupcakes & certificates for all involved.
